TONE

This spot is a spirited combination of sincerity and playfulness with a touch of magic. The earnest VO delivered in a child's voice will serve as the heart of the piece, while the juxtapositions of holiday visuals like sleepy parents and antlered dog provide a breezy touch of comedy to balance out any over sentimentality. At the store, our child steps front and center to become the hero of the piece, delivering their toy to the donation booth before we pump up the feel-good vibes as we see the toy change another child's Christmas forever. Finally, we'll sprinkle a bit of Christmas magic on the final beat, as the new kid's eyes light up at the prospect of their new toy delivering an extra special message only they can hear!













We open on snow coming down outside a bedroom window. A child wakes up, excited! Is it Christmas already?! They quickly hop out of bed, grabbing a colorful pen and some paper that they begin scribbling a note on. "Dear Santa..."

As we hear the child read their letter, we intercut with scenes of their family going on a fun Christmas quest, our kid always bubbling with excitement and cheer as their parents good naturedly keep up.

"I hope I'm not interrupting a long winter's nap..." the kid jumps on their parents' bed, eager for everyone to get up Up UP! "And that the reindeer are doing well..."

CUT TO: our kid adjusting some toy reindeer antlers on the long suffering family dog in between bites of breakfast. Mom and Dad try to down some coffee out of matching holiday mugs in the kitchen.


"This Christmas, I wanted to ask you for something EXTRA special, if that's okay?" We see our family—bundled up in festive winter clothes—leaving the decked halls of their house behind in the family van.

Things take a more sentimental turn, as we soon realize this loveable kid is taking the magic of the holiday season into their own hands this year. "It's SUPER important."

CUT TO: The child staring upwards, brow furrowed as they think through a VERY important decision. "I wouldn't normally ask, but since you're Santa and all, I knew you'd understand." The child points—that one- and Mom reaches up, pulling down an adorable plushie from (what we reveal) is the toy aisle they've been standing in.

OUTSIDE: Our Kid holds the plush toy close as the family exits the store. "If you could make sure a SPECIAL kid on your list gets this, I'd really appreciate it." Mom points and the child rushes over to a TOYS FOR TOTS table. They skid to a stop just short, taking a moment whispering in the toy's ear so only we can hear-- "Say hi from me, okay?"—before proudly presenting their gift to a Marine.

CUTTO: Another living room in another home on Christmas morning. We see a different child opening up a gift—it's the plushie! They hug it close, then their eyes widen. They lean in, listening carefully. Suddenly, the child giggles. We end with keyables/VO that play out over these ending beats.
